

REACHING THE 10-40 WINDOW IN WEST AFRICA

We are incredibly thankful for partners like you who support the mission to meet needs and feed souls around the world. While we are not a church, we desire to execute our mission in a way that builds the global church and local churches. We share the common purpose of helping people know God, and like you we embrace the make a difference that brings Jesus all the glory. To that end, we present this proposal which, if funded, will help us develop leaders and further scale kingdom building ministry in unreached and under-reached areas of West Africa.

Our Request: We are asking that you prayerfully consider the following proposal to fund the construction of our West Africa Regional Office. The financial breakdown for the proposal is listed below, and the impact of this grant is detailed on the following pages.

REACHING THE 10-40 WINDOW IN WEST AFRICA

On a survey trip to Togo in 2010, Vapor Ministries' Founder & CEO, Micah McElveen, witnessed desperate spiritual and physical needs from the moment he arrived. He could not ignore the children who were suffering from severe malnutrition, or the men and women who sought acceptance through voodoo rituals and sacrifice to false gods. In fact, the area had one known church and was estimated to be 99.2% non-evangelical. In 2011, Vapor's third center was established in Togoville. Today, the area is undergoing physical, spiritual, and economic transformation due to the programs operated by Vapor Ministries.

Surrounding the country of Togo, lie several underdeveloped countries with severely unreached people groups. These people groups, located in the 10-40 window, are considered less than 1% evangelical. In addition, the majority of the tens of millions of people in these countries live in extreme poverty. Obeying God's call to serve the poor and bring the Gospel to the nations, Vapor Ministries plans to establish a Regional Office in Togoville from which we can train and send indigenous missionaries from our Haiti and Africa centers into these unreached areas.

Spiritual Highlights

- Over a thousand new believers professed faith in Christ, many from voodoo and animistic roots, through outreach since center opening including one of the highest ranking voodoo priests in the country who served the president
- Approximately 750 children, youth, and adults are enrolled in our disciple making groups.
- Future leaders are being developed and strategies formed to further advance the gospel in the region
- Gospel resources and scriptures are being dispersed to those who have never heard the name of Jesus
- 8 new churches planted in Togoville since center launch with several of our staff members pastoring or serving in these churches

Physical Highlights


- Around 750 receiving basic health, sanitation, and disease avoidance training
- Hundreds of life-threatening physical needs being met through our critical care grants
- Over 55 indigenous leaders, staff & part time coaches, earning wages in service to their communities
- Clean water is being provided to thousands from our "Joshua Well"
- 54 children currently sponsored for education and basic needs through our Hasmin's Friends program
- Food and farming education being provided to the community through our agricultural initiatives



WEST AFRICA REGIONAL OFFICE PROPOSAL

Our vision to scale outreach in unreached areas of West Africa will require locally based regional leadership. A West Africa Regional Office, housed at our Togoville center, will become the training ground for developing leaders and deploying missionaries who will launch new outreach new centers and open the doors for new churches in under-served areas in West Africa. Leadership in this Regional Office will provide oversight and support to deployed staff as they face the unique challenges of ministry in West Africa such as deep beliefs in voodoo and animism.






